## 2020 LOC Board of Directors

### **Positions Open**

*Officers.* The officers of the League of Oregon Cities, all held by elected officials, are: President, Vice President, Treasurer and Immediate Past President. Unless there is a vacancy, only the position of the Treasurer is open; the other officers rotate upward.

**Directors.** In addition to the officers, the LOC's Bylaws provide for 11 voting Directors and one non-voting Director. Directors represent all geographic regions of the state and varied city populations. Directors serve three-year terms that begin with the first meeting of the new calendar year following the election. For the 2020 Board of Directors, there are open seats for three Director positions and one Treasurer. (An additional Director position may be filled in the event the Treasurer position is filled by a current Board member with an unexpired term.) Of the three open Director positions, one is for a city manager or administrator. For the first year of the three-year term, this position will be non-voting. If you are interested in this seat, please advise the Oregon City/County Management Association (OCCMA). The LOC Nominating Committee is required to consider the recommendation of the OCCMA.

New Board members will be given an orientation in early December at LOC offices in Salem. The new term of office begins with the first meeting of 2020, usually held in late February.

#### **Nomination Process**

All candidates for a Board position will be expected to do the following:

**Complete an Application Form.** Return a completed Application Form (next page) to LOC offices by **August 29**, **2019**. This will provide the Nominating Committee with general background on all candidates for office. Appear Before the Nominating Committee. The LOC Nominating Committee will hold a public meeting during the LOC Annual Conference in Bend on Thursday, September 26. Each applicant will be given a set amount of time to address the committee.
