

2021 General Government LEGISLATIVE WATCH LIST

GENERAL GOVERNMENT

HB 2086 – Behavioral Health Investments

Appropriates moneys to Oregon Health Authority to undertake specified steps to address needs of individuals with behavioral health disorders for services, treatment and housing. Declares emergency, effective on passage. LOC supports this bill.

HB 2205 – Allows State Laws to be Enforced by Civil Action

This bill would allow for a civil action to enforce laws such as BOLI statutes. LOC opposes this bill.

HB 2207 – Eliminates Local Tort Cap

Eliminates the lower tort cap for local governments and applies the higher state tort cap to all local governments. LOC opposes this bill.

HB 2367- Right-to-Rest

Prevents local governments from enforcing no-trespass, anti-camping or sidewalk ordinances on those experience houselessness. LOC opposes this bill.

HB 2678 – Ranked Choice Voting

Establishes ranked choice voting for the election of state, city and county offices except where a Home Rule charter applies.

HB 2758 – Include Public Health on OLCC

Requires that two members of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission have a background in public health. LOC supports this bill.

HB 2930 – Police Collective Bargaining

Imposes limitations on arbitrators' decisions concerning alleged misconduct by law enforcement officers. Prescribes method for selecting arbitrator to serve in arbitration proceeding concerning law enforcement officer misconduct. Establishes Commission on Statewide Law Enforcement Standards of Conduct and Discipline to adopt uniform standards of conduct for law enforcement officers and disciplinary standards by which law enforcement agencies and arbitrators shall make determinations regarding imposition of disciplinary action against law enforcement officers. The LOC is working to amend this bill.
