

Application and Election Process for ELECTED CITY OFFICIAL DIRECTOR POSITION

2022 LOC Board of Directors

Position Open

The LOC's Bylaws provide for 9 Elected City Official Director positions on the Board. Directors represent all geographic regions of the state and varied city populations. Directors serve three-year terms that begin with the first meeting of the new calendar year following the election. For the 2022 Board of Directors, there are three open seats for the Elected Official Director positions. (An additional Director position may be filled in the event the Treasurer position is filled by a current Board member with an unexpired term.)

New board members will be given an orientation in December and will participate in the Strategic Planning Session with the current Board scheduled on December 9, 2021. New board members will also participate, but not be permitted to vote, in the December 10, 2021 Board Meeting. The new term of office begins with the first meeting of 2022, usually held in late February.

Nomination Process for Appointed Officials

All candidates for the Board position designated for an Elected City Official Director will be expected to do the following:

Complete an Application Form. Return a completed Application Form (next page) to Angela Speier at aspeier@orcities.org by **October 6, 2021**. This will provide the Nominating Committee with general background on all candidates for office.

Appear Before the Nominating Committee. The LOC Nominating Committee will hold a virtual public meeting on Thursday, October 21, 2021. Each applicant will be given a set amount of time to address the committee.
