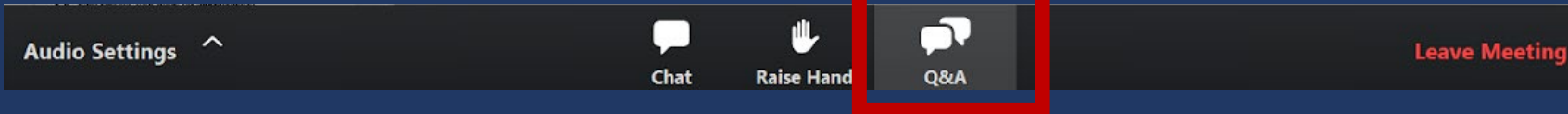

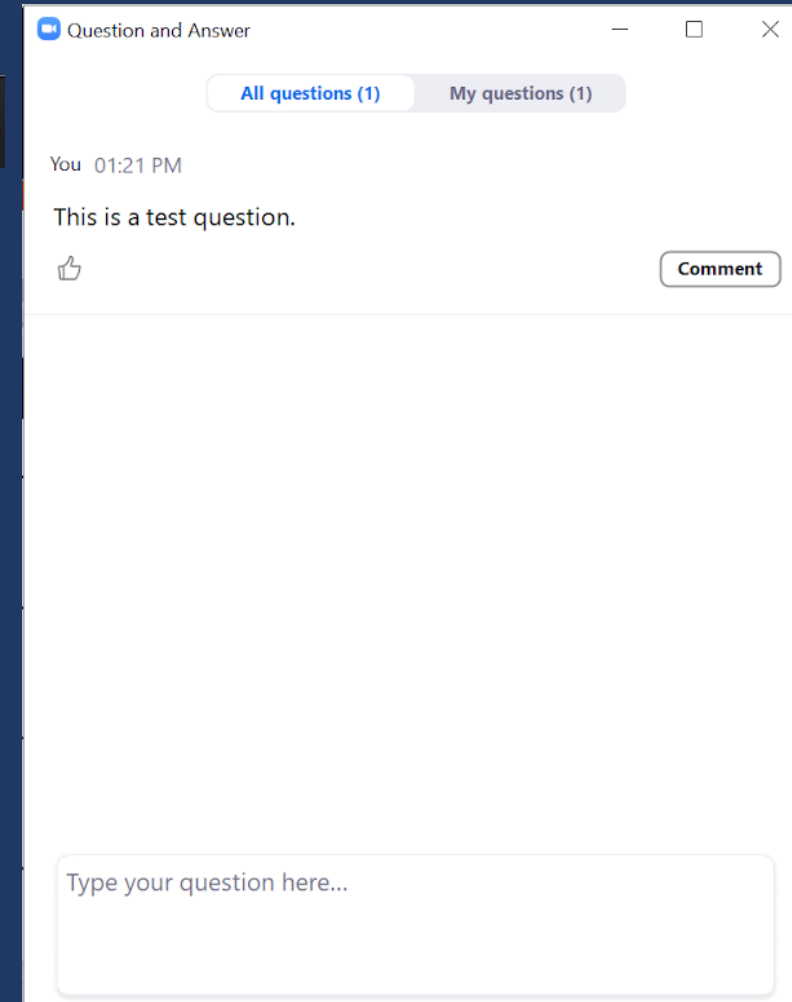

Landscape

- Major budget deficits due to H.R. 1 and transportation package referral
- Addressing federal action
- 285 measures introduced, LOC is tracking >55% of bills



Transportation Updates



- Working to maintain city's 20% share of the State Highway Fund
- [HB 4085](#) - creates state autonomous vehicle framework, **preempts local governments**, Opposed
- [HB 4007](#) - regulates micromobility devices, amendment coming to improve local control, Moving to neutral
- [HB 4008](#) - creates transit funding task force
- [HB 4009](#) & [HB 4126](#) - phase in of a per-mile road charge & study real costs
- [SB 1542](#) & [SB 1543](#) - ODOT accountability and Oregon Transportation Commission membership

Revenue & Finance Updates



- State budget constraints, new revenue forecast lessens impact
- [HB 4015](#) - federal disconnect conversations
- LOCAL Act ([HB 4148](#)) - creates flexibility for use of transient lodging tax revenue
 - **LOC Priority bill**

General Government & Public Safety Updates



- [SB 1563](#) - allow parties to bring a civil action against public agencies for the deprivation of rights guaranteed under the Oregon Constitution, Opposed
- [SB 1569](#) - adds evidence and fingerprint technicians to the Public Employee Retirement System (PERS) police and fire worker category, Opposed
- [HB 4094](#) - require employers to pay out a minimum of 300 hours of accrued vacation time when an employee leaves their position, Opposed
- [HB 4138](#) - mandates masking for law enforcement and more, current draft increases city liability and creates a civil right of action, Opposed to portions of the bill
 - [HB 4001](#) - omnibus immigration enforcement package

- [HB 4037](#) – Omnibus housing bill
- [HB 4035](#) – One-time UGB Expansion Program Update
- [HB 4082](#) – One-time UGB Expansions for Manufactured Homes and Senior Housing
- [HB 4108](#) – Non-contiguous annexation
- [SB 1521](#) – Inclusionary Housing Program
- [SB 1586](#) – Sen. Sollman's JOBS Act
- [HB 4084](#) – Gov. Kotek's Prosperity Roadmap Package

Energy & Telecom Updates



- [SB 1526](#) - Fund for Oregon Resilience, Growth, and Energy (FORGE) Act, Support
- [SB 1582](#) - Dispersed Power Plant, Support
- [HB 4032](#) - Geographically dispersed emergency fuel sites, Monitor
- [HB 4031](#) - Expedited siting of renewable energy facilities, Support
- [HB 4055](#) - 48-Hour Notice Requirement to State CIO after discovery of a cyberattack, Oppose

Water, Waste, & Natural Resources Updates



- [HB 4005](#) – Water Professional Appreciation Week
- [SB 1585](#) – Reduces grant matching requirements for small cities
