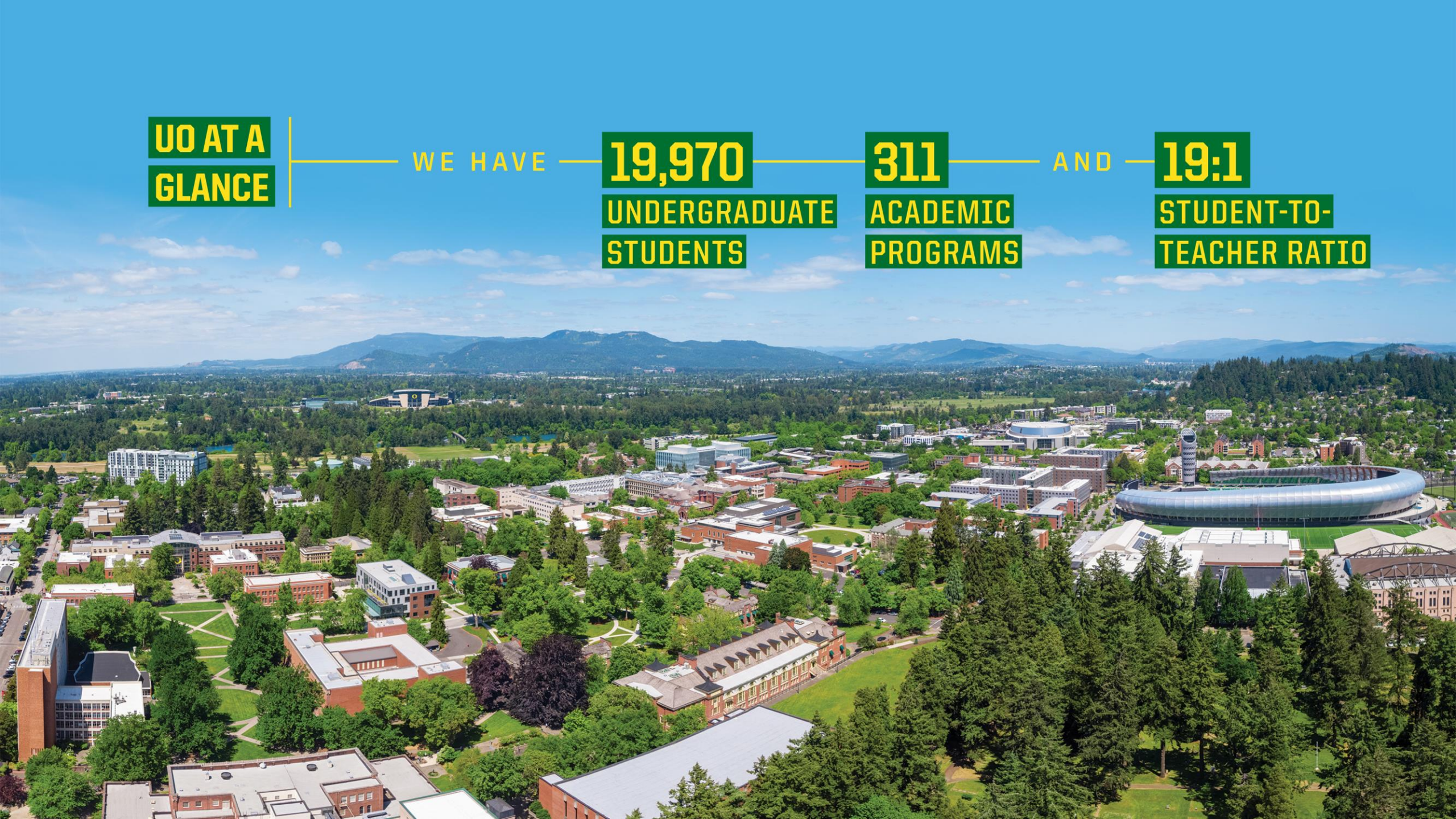

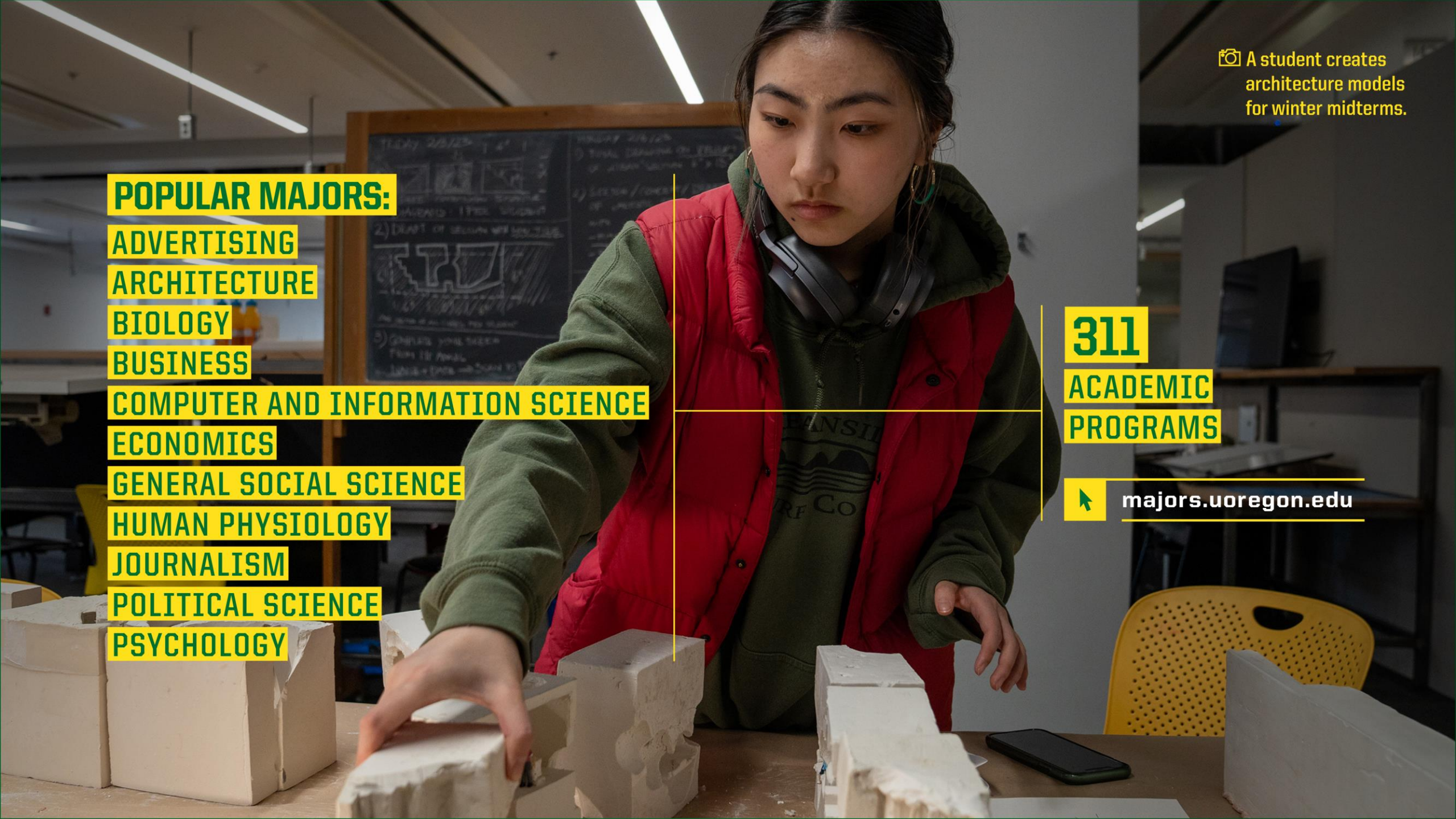

### Admissions Factors

---

GPA and overall grade trend

---

Senior year schedule

---

Activities and accomplishments, including employment or other responsibilities outside of school

---

Personal essay

---

SAT or ACT (test optional)

---

### Required high school courses

---

**English:** 4 years

---

**Math:** 3 years

---

**Social science:** 3 years

---

**Second language:** 2 years

---

**Science:** 3 years

---

### Key application deadlines

---

**November 1:** Early action deadline to receive your admission decision by December 30

---

**January 15:** Regular application deadline and UO Scholarship consideration deadline

---

**February 15:** Deadline for STAR and Automatic Merit Scholarships

---

**May 1:** National Decision Day

## Application Process

---

To apply, use either the **Common Application** or **Oregon Application**

---

Both applications open on **August 1** and must be completed by the appropriate application deadline.

## STARS Record (Self-reported Transcript and Academic Record System)

---

List course names as they appear on your transcript

Include in-progress senior-year courses

Enter course credits amount as shown on your transcript

---

**February 15:** Deadline for STARS Record and Automatic Merit Scholarships

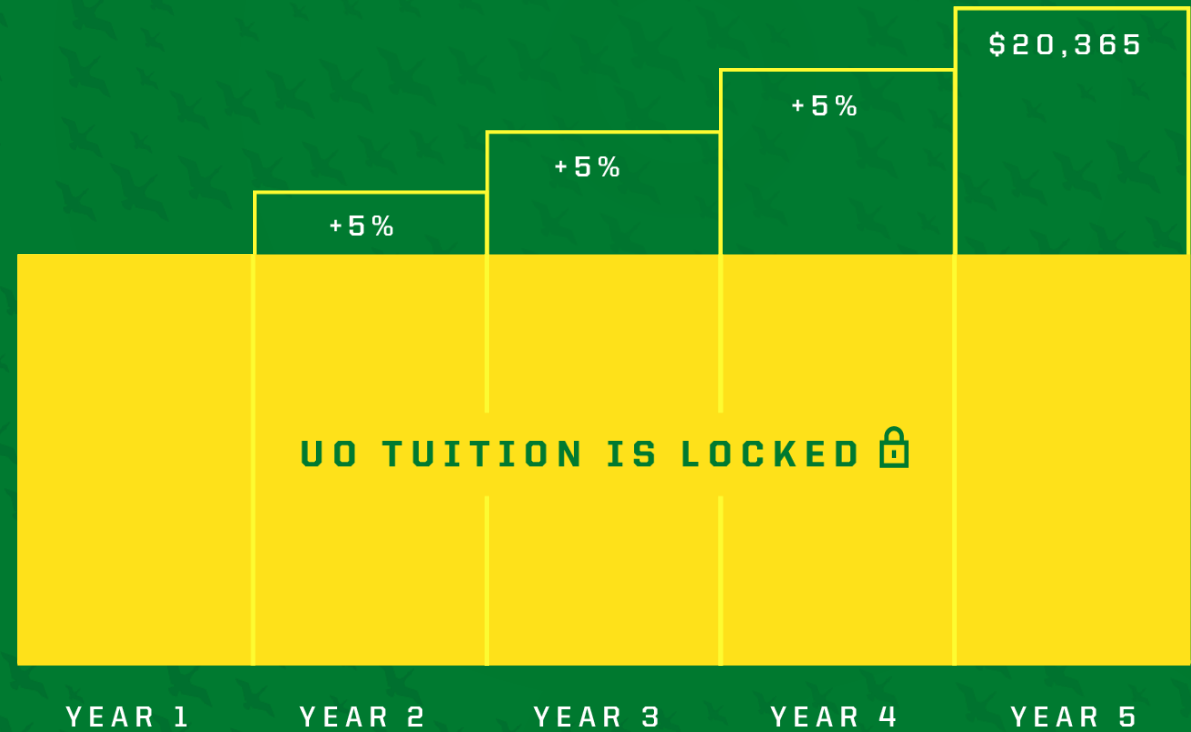

## SCHOLARSHIPS

### Automatic Consideration\*

#### Summit

Minimum 3.90 GPA | \$5,000 per year

#### Apex

3.70–3.89 GPA | \$2,000 per year

#### National Merit

National Merit finalist who lists UO as first choice on the National Merit Scholarship application | \$2,000 per year

#### Pathway Oregon

Oregon residents who graduate from an Oregon high school | minimum 3.40 GPA | Pell Grant eligible | covers full tuition and fees

#### General University

Academic merit criteria varies and will be determined on a case-by-case basis | \$1,500

#### International Baccalaureate

IB diploma | IB test score of 24 or higher | minimum 3.40 GPA | \$1,000-\$3,000 per year

### Additional Application Required

#### Stamps

Minimum 3.85 GPA | selection based on academic and extracurricular factors | covers full UO tuition, fees, room, and board for four years

#### Presidential

Oregon resident | minimum 3.85 GPA | \$36,000 over four years of undergraduate study

#### Diversity Excellence

Minimum 3.0 GPA | selection based on financial need, academic and extracurricular factors, and contribution to UO diversity mission | \$7,500 per year

#### Home Flight

Oregon residents and enrolled citizens of a federally recognized tribe | covers full tuition and fees

\* Applications for admission must be submitted by January 15 for automatic consideration scholarships.

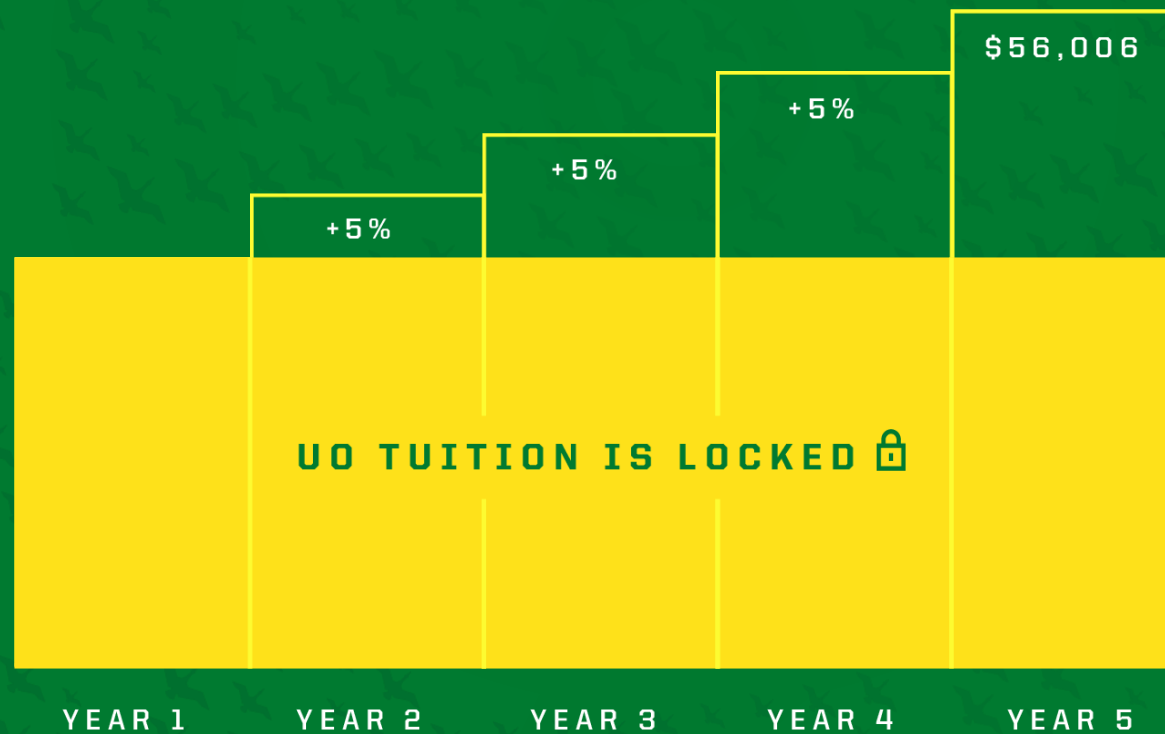

<b>Summit</b>	Minimum 3.90 GPA   \$12,500 per year
<b>Apex</b>	3.70–3.89 GPA   \$10,000 per year
<b>National Merit</b>	National Merit finalist who lists UO as first choice on the National Merit Scholarship application   \$2,000 per year
<b>General University</b>	Academic merit criteria varies and will be determined on a case-by-case basis   \$1,500
<b>International Baccalaureate</b>	IB diploma   IB test score of 24 or higher   minimum 3.40 GPA   \$1,000–\$3,000 per year

### Additional Application Required

<b>Stamps</b>	Minimum 3.85 GPA   selection based on academic and extracurricular factors   full UO tuition, fees, room, and board for four years
<b>Diversity Excellence</b>	Minimum 3.0 GPA   selection based on financial need, academic and extracurricular factors, and contribution to UO diversity mission   \$7,500 per year
<b>Home Flight</b>	Oregon residents and enrolled citizens of a federally recognized tribe   covers full tuition and fees

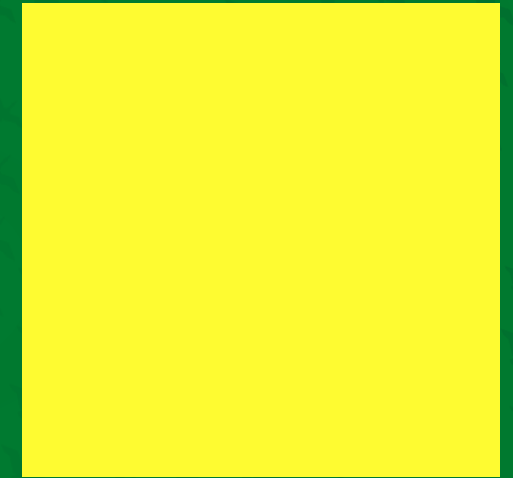

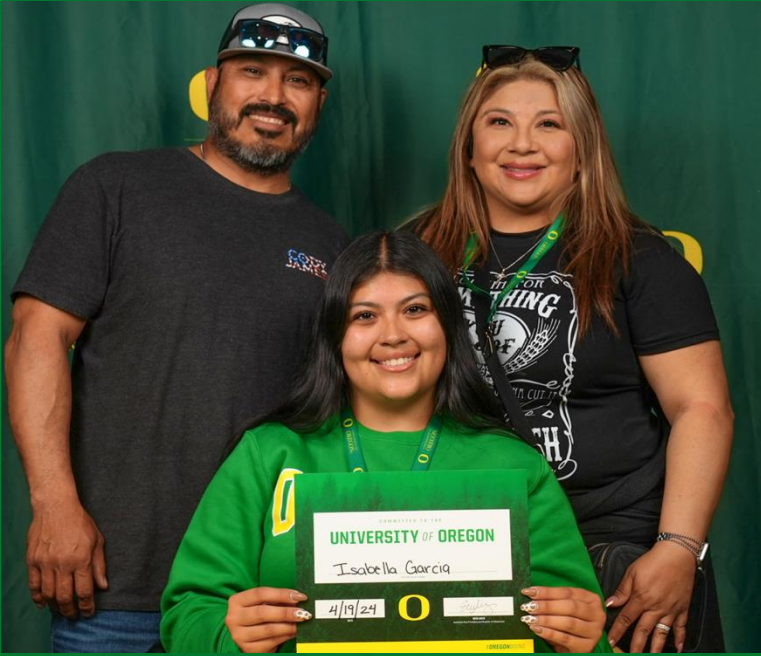
