

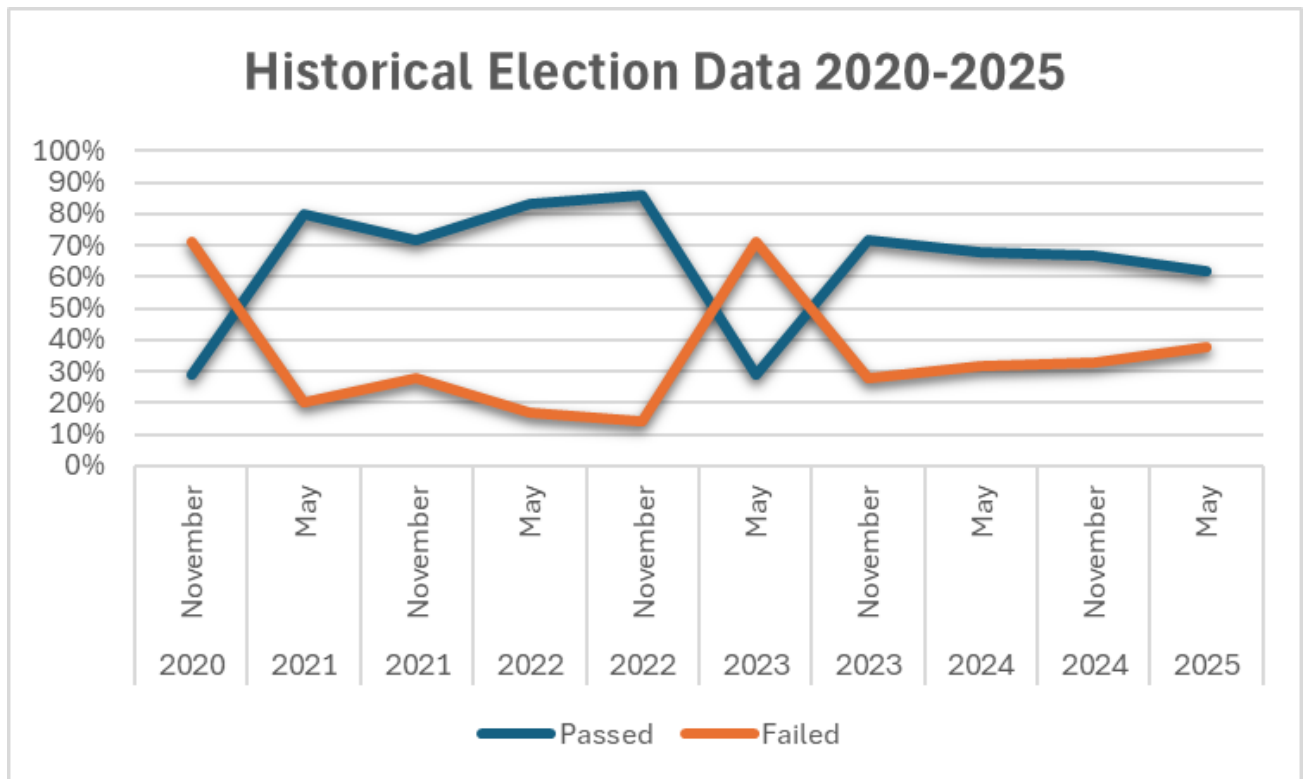


May 20, 2025 Election

Unofficial Results as of 5/28/2025

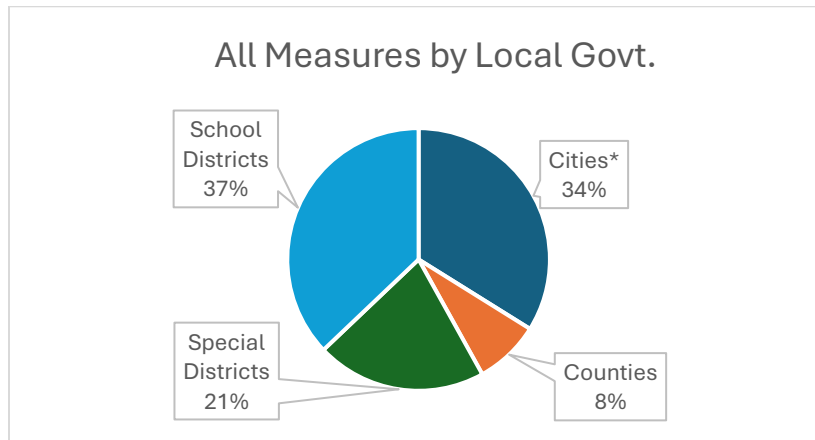

For a comparison of 2020-2025 elections, please see chart below.



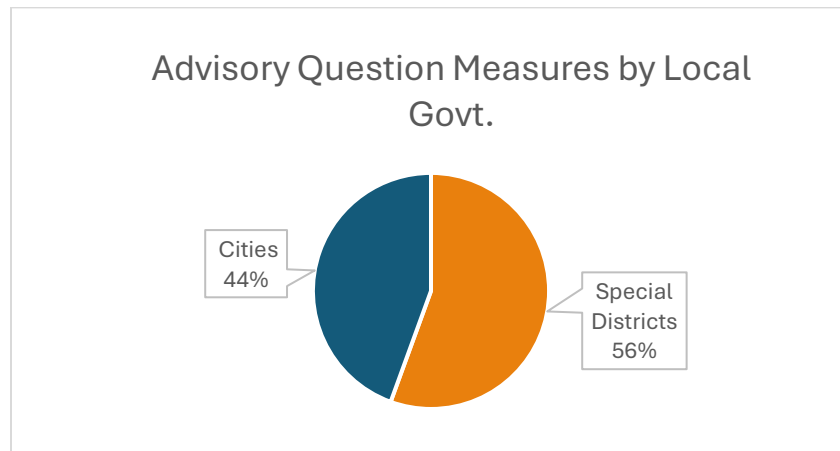

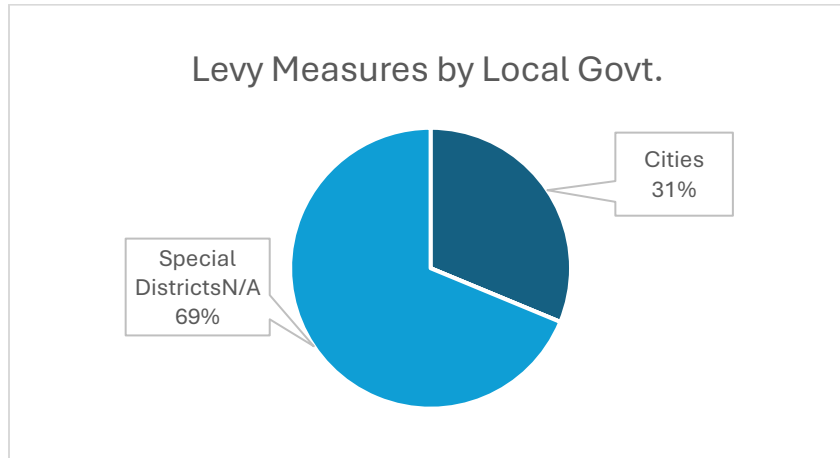

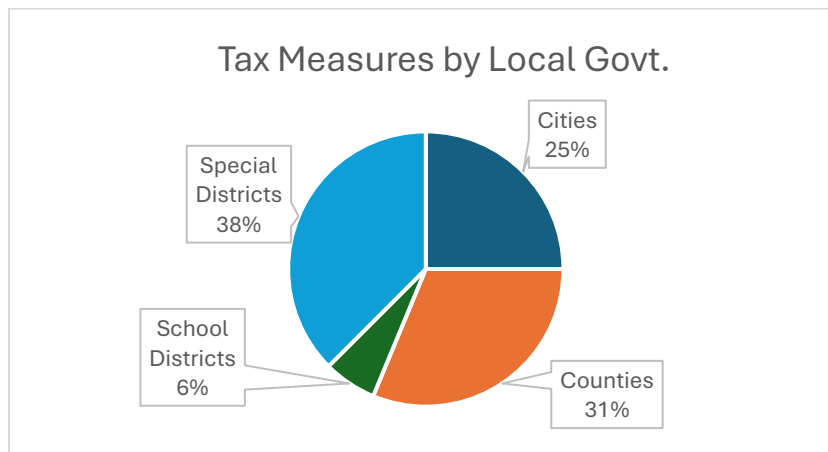

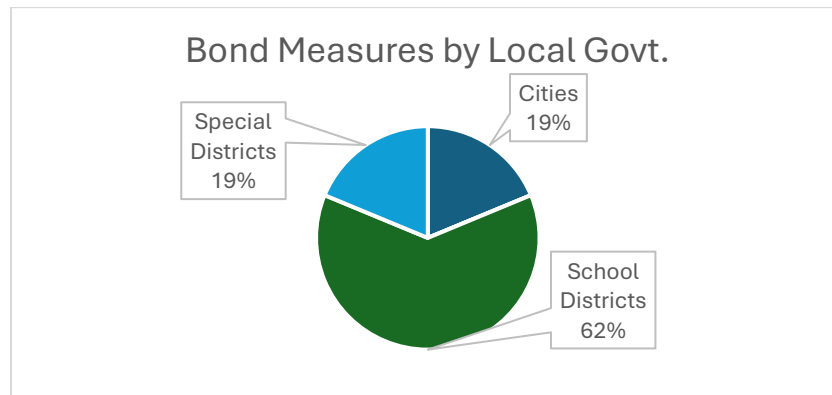

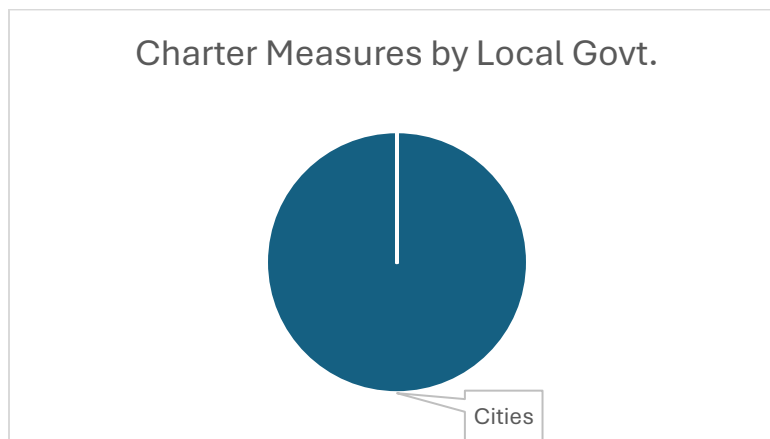
