Board of Directors

The bylaws of the Women's Caucus provide for a 13-member Board of Directors. A candidate must be a current member of the Women's Caucus to be eligible for election.

Under the bylaws:

- Directors are elected to a term of office that is one year in length.
- Election will take place at the Women's Caucus Annual Membership meeting, which is scheduled for October Friday, October 16, at noon, in conjunction with LOC's Annual Conference in Salem.

Appear Before the Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee will hold a public meeting, and the date and time are TBD. Each applicant will be given a set amount of time to address the committee. This meeting will be a hybrid meeting (in-person or virtual).
